

One Belt, One Road Initiative - Summary

One Belt One Road Initiative is a global development strategy adopted by the Chinese government involving infrastructure development and investments in 152 countries and international organizations in Asia, Europe, Africa, the Middle East, and the Americas.

In total, US\$1.3 trillion having already been initiated under the One-Belt One-Road banner. To compare it is more than seven times the size of the Marshall Plan. The Marshall Plan triggered the reconstruction and then recovery of war-torn Europe almost 70 years ago.
